Project: Digital Closing Dinner Invitation

I created this digital invite for a celebratory dinner for one of Deutsche Bank's high profile clients. It was celebrating their client's \$37B acquisition of another company which was the largest chip industry deal at the time.

This invite was one of three concepts I proposed and definitely the most humorous. Often these types of dinner invitations would simply be an interior shot of the restaurant where the event was being hosted. But after working extremely hard on closing this deal the Investment Banking team appreciated adding a bit of levity to the occasion.

In general the bank's branding style guides were quite strict and all imagery used had to be photorealistic. While it would have been something to set up a photo shoot with an actual buffalo, our tight design deadlines and surprisingly small design budgets never allowed for such things. I created the image by compositing elements in Photoshop while doing the final layout in Indesign.

Project: Deutsche Bank Pocket sized emergency contact card

Business continuity in the face of emergencies is very important for a global investment bank. I created this while working in DB Creative at Deutsche Bank. This project was for the Risk Business Management Team and distributed to all New York employees. There was a lot of content that the team wanted to include and they wanted it to be something people could carry in their wallet, so I designed a double sided 3.5" x 2.5" accordion fold out card. I was responsible for all aspects of the card design, including creation of the cover art, 4 maps with assembly points and street routes, and the text layout for the front and back of the card.

Artwork was created using Adobe Photoshop and Illustrator, layout was done in InDesign, printing and lamination coordinated with an outside print vendor.

12 panel fold out brochure created for the Deutsche Bank's Life science industry conference.







Project: Roadshow presentation design for Deutsche Bank's client Dropbox


